### **Historic Walking Tour of Santa Fe**

**Time: 2:00pm-3:30pm**

This is a leisurely one and a half-hour stroll through more than 400 years of history, art, and culture. The walking tour presents an extraordinary introduction to Santa Fe, and provides an entertaining, humorous, and accurate portrayal of the "City Different." Your professional guide will lead the group to the historic Plaza and to the Palace of the Governors (whose occupants have included government and military leaders from Spain, Mexico, and the Confederacy, the U.S. and Indian Nations). The group members will learn about St. Francis Cathedral, and explore the Loretto Chapel and its miraculous staircase; the oldest church; the Capitol, and other major Santa Fe historical sites. The tour can end either at the Plaza, where the walkers are free to shop and browse on their own, or it can end back at the Hotel. Tour includes minimum one and a half-hour private walking tour, entry to Loretto Chapel, certified, professional guide, one guide for every twenty guests, and guide gratuities.

### **Secrets of Canyon Road Tour**

**Time: 1:30pm-4:30pm**

Santa Fe's Canyon Road, one of America's oldest and most charming neighborhoods, is comprised of residences, restaurants, galleries and shops. In your guided stroll down Canyon Road, you will see some of Santa Fe finest galleries, which will include art works

of longtime favorites as well as exciting newcomers. Learn the origins of the magnificent artistry of our Pueblos and hear gallery and shop owners discuss their collections. Tour includes transportation, private tour, guide, and guide and driver gratuities.

### **Bandelier National Monument Tour**

**8:00am – 12:30pm**

Travel northwest out of Santa Fe to Bandelier National Monument, and descend into a canyon filled with the ruins of the Anasazi Indians, colloquially "the Ancient Ones." Located on the Pajarito Plateau of the Jemez Mountains, Bandelier was the home of the Anasazi from the eleventh to fourteenth centuries. Excavated over 90 years ago, these ruins were once home to over 200 people, ancestors of today's Pueblo Indians. Guests may walk along easy paths past the remains of ancient Pueblo dwellings, to the cliff dwellings where they can climb ladders to peer inside.

### **Santa Fe School of Cooking**

Founded in 1989, The Santa Fe School of Cooking offers 22 regularly-scheduled classes showcasing the distinctive foods and flavors of the Southwest. The Santa Fe School of Cooking offers these classes in a demonstration-style format where guests watch a chef prepare a meal. The menu on this particular day will Lime-Marinated Salmon Fillet, Corn and Black Bean Salsa, Green Chile Scalloped Potatoes, Southwest Stir-Fried Vegetables, Wild Green Salad with Orange-Sherry Vinaigrette Dressing, and Vanilla Flan.

### **Taos Tour**

**Time: 9:00am-5:00pm**

Enjoy a full-day Taos tour to include: driving the scenic high road and stop in the historic village of Chimayo; tour the charming Santuario de Chimayo, known for the professed healing powers contained in the earth; then on to Centinela, where seven generations of the Trujillo family have produced their spectacular Spanish-style weavings; proceed to Taos and the enchanting San Francisco de Assisi Church; enjoy lunch at the Apple Tree Restaurant in historic Taos Plaza; onto Taos Pueblo framed by the sacred Taos Mountains. Taos has been designated a World Heritage Site. Other stops can include the Millicent Rogers Museum and the Taos Gorge. Please note that Santa Fe Destinations is not responsible for unscheduled Taos Pueblo closing due to births or deaths of tribal members. Tour includes lunch, transportation, professional guide, entrance fees and guide and driver gratuities.
